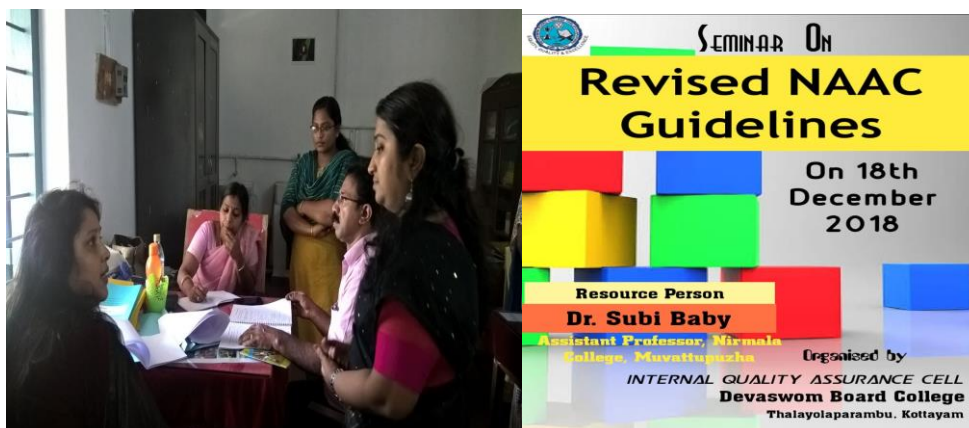
Induction Programme for 1st UG Students

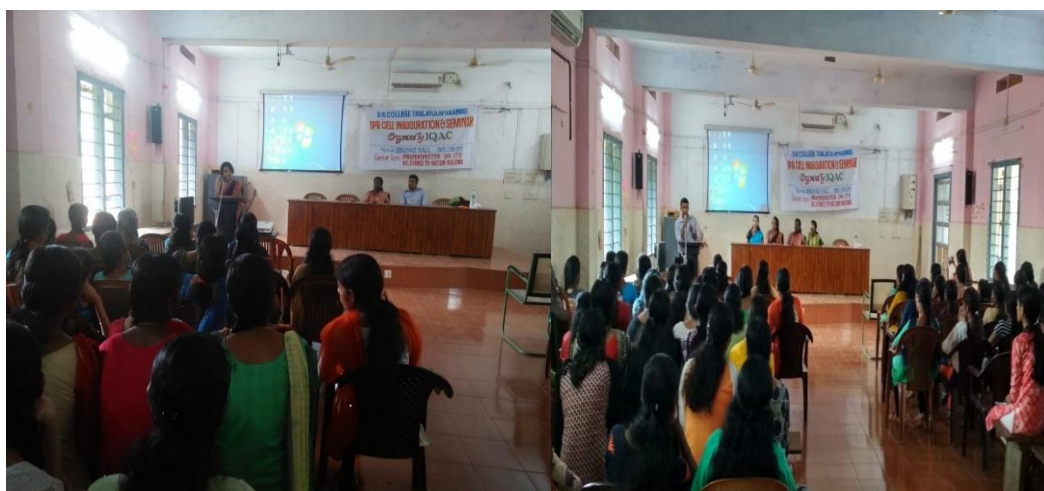
