





Date 12 06 2021







World suicide prevention day


September 10 2021






Poster of doves made by Students on international peace day






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World Aids Day December 1 2021

After the covid 10 pandemic the library was completely closed and all books under destruction. Our Volunteers went for cleaning and restoration of the library








International day of people with disability

December 9 2021





April 2 2022


