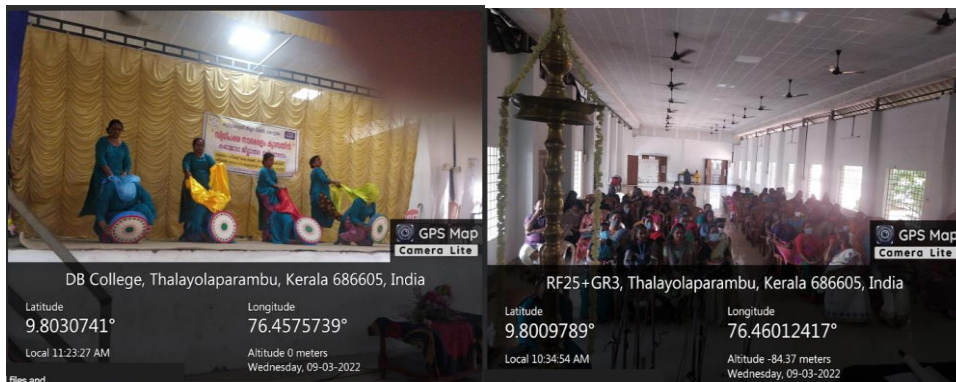

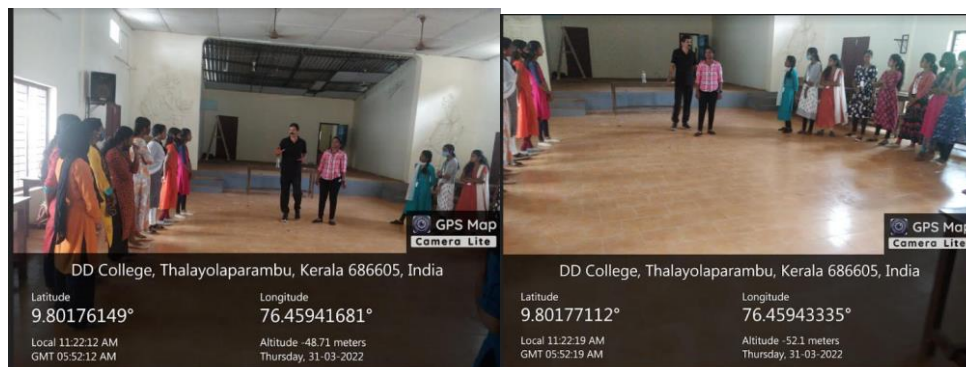


**Day 1 of Women's Self Defence Training Programme**

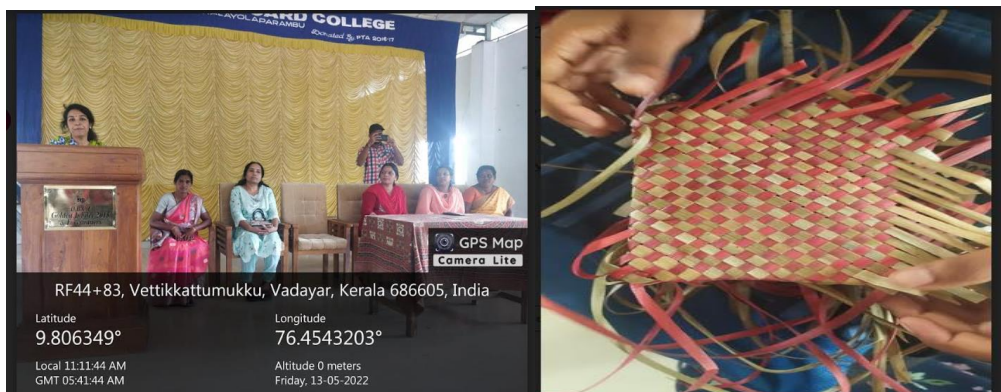
### Sri. Nandhakumar, Crime Branch Sub Inspector of Police, demonstrating self-defence to the students

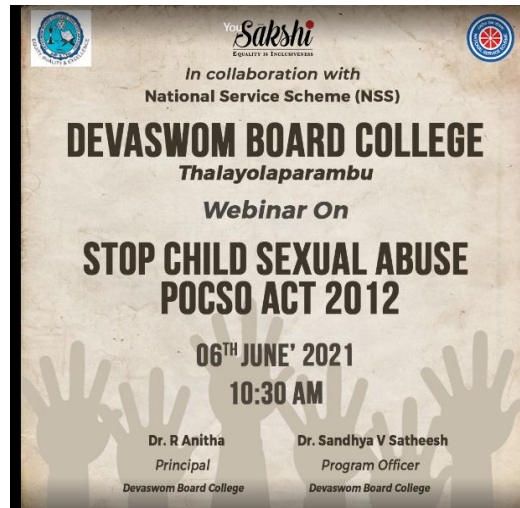


### Inaugural function of craft class and handbag making using ‘thazhappaya’
