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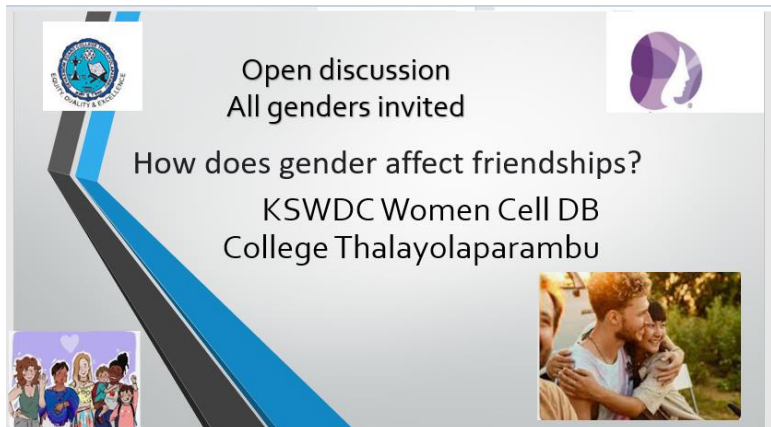

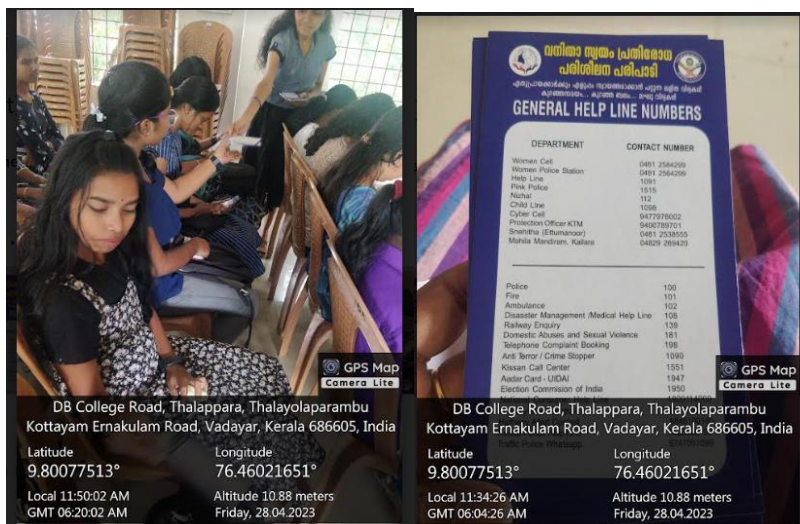
Activities of Day 3: 28 -04-23
