
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ACTIVITIES OF BHOOMITHRASENA

ACTIVITIES OF BIO DIVERSITY CLUB

 Environment Day celebrations: Biodiversity club of Devaswom Board College, Thalayolaparambu celebrates World Environmental Day every year on June 5th. The theme for the year was 'Only one earth' – let's make it clean and green. The day was celebrated by planting of herbs (medicinal plants) in the herbal garden by the students. Principal Dr. R. Anitha inaugurated the function. The students themselves brought the plants available from their locality and planted them in the garden as well at the Shantistall.





ACTIVITIES OF NSS

• Setting up a garden with various crops/vegetables with a theme "Youth for Healthier Environment": With the theme, "Youth for Healthier Environment, on 06/06/22, the NSS unit of Devaswom Board College, Thalayolaparambu planted tapioca, ginger, Colocasia yams and turmeric in an area of 50 cents and to maintain, preserve support and upkeep of crops/vegetables garden. 

For the data collection and enrolment of the houses and institution at Haritha Mitram App, aimed for complete digitalization of Harithakarmasena activities in panachyats, the NSS volunteers went for a three day data collection and survey in Kaduthuruthy panchayath from 22/10/22.


DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES
