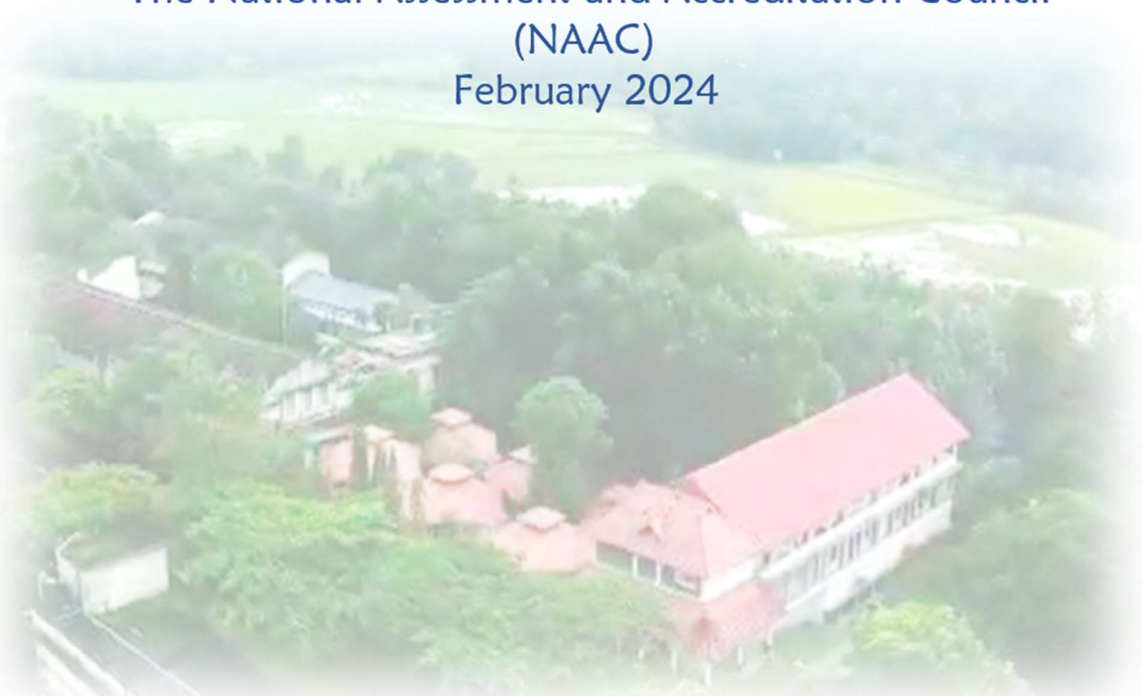

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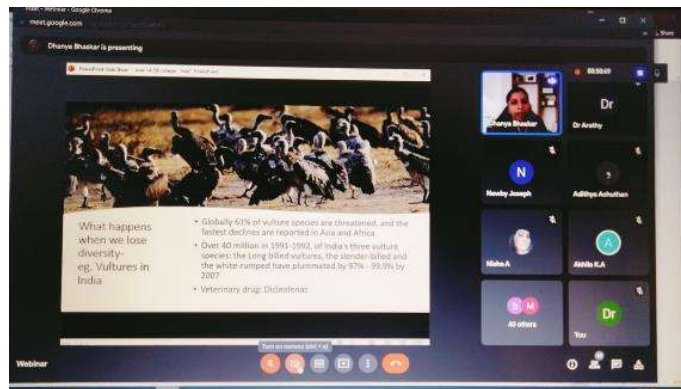
Participative Learning

Participative learning is an educational approach that involves active involvement of students in the learning process. It emphasizes collaboration, interaction, and engagement among students and between students and instructors. In participative learning, students are encouraged to take an active role in their own learning by participating in discussions, group activities and other interactive learning experiences.

This approach contrasts with traditional methods of teaching where the instructor plays a more passive role in imparting knowledge to students. Participative learning enhances student motivation, critical thinking skills, communication abilities, and overall understanding of the subject matter. It fosters a learner-centered environment where students can explore concepts, ask questions, and construct their own knowledge through hands-on experiences.

The college implements the participative learning technique in the following ways

- Seminars / Webinars – interactive sessions with external experts

- Debates/ Group Discussions – Open forums are held by the departments and clubs in topics both of academic interest as well as current topics



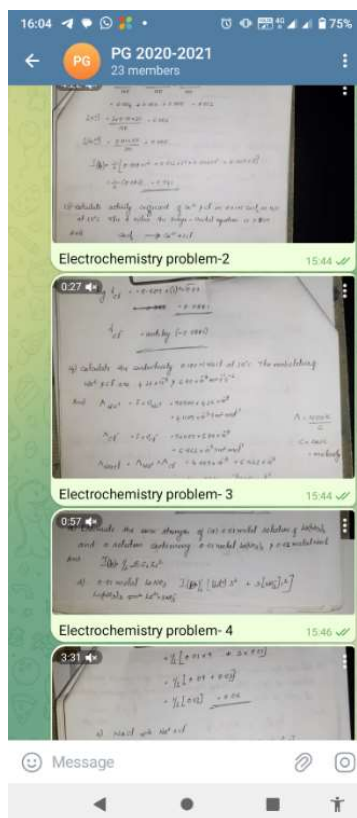
Debate: Environmental exploitation is necessary for development – Wetland Day [2018-19]
