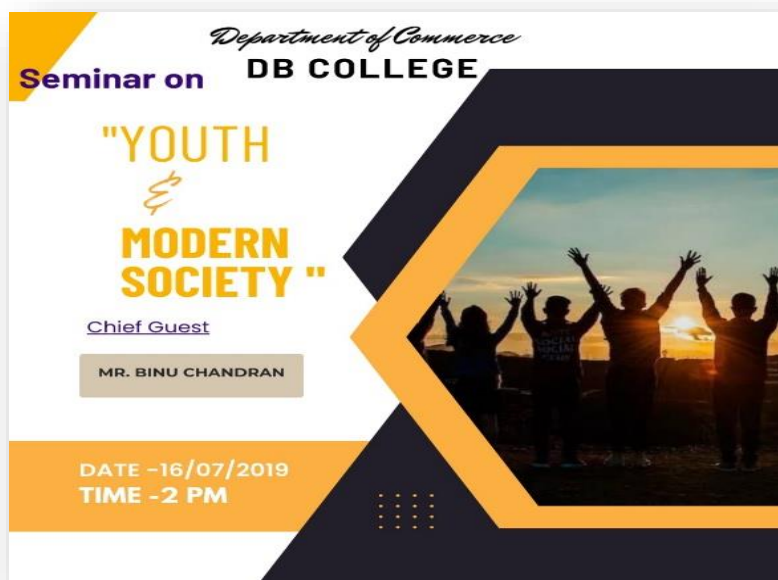

TOPIC: CHANDRAYAN 2

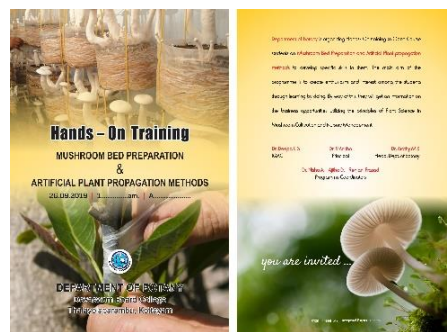

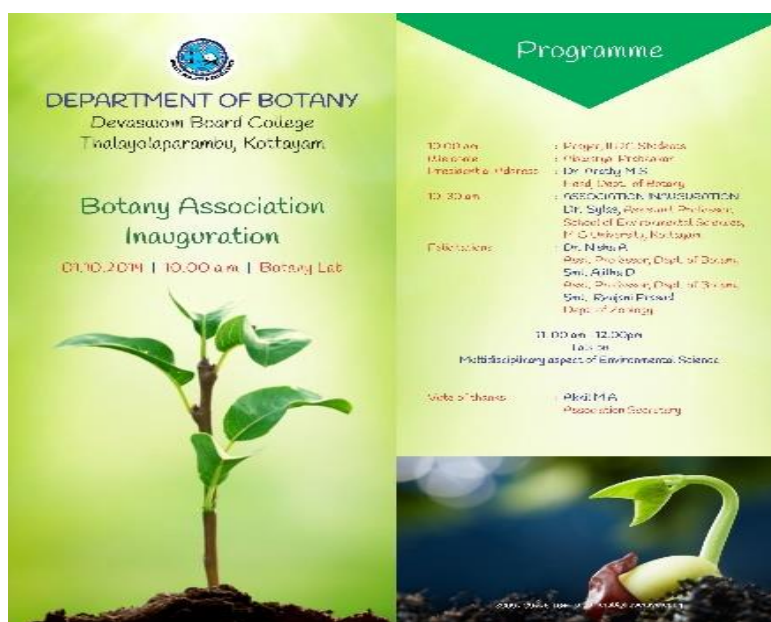

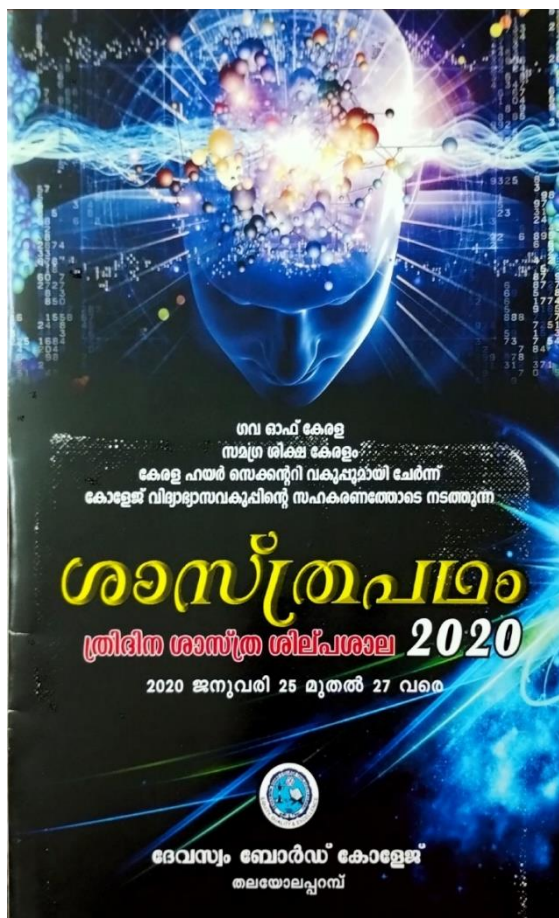


WORKSHOP CUM RESIDENTIAL CAMP
