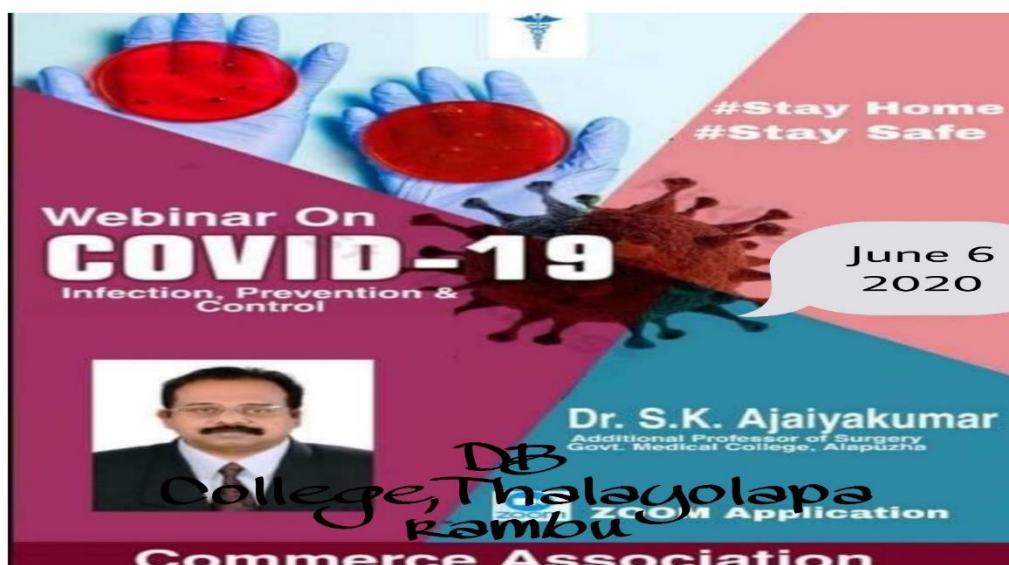

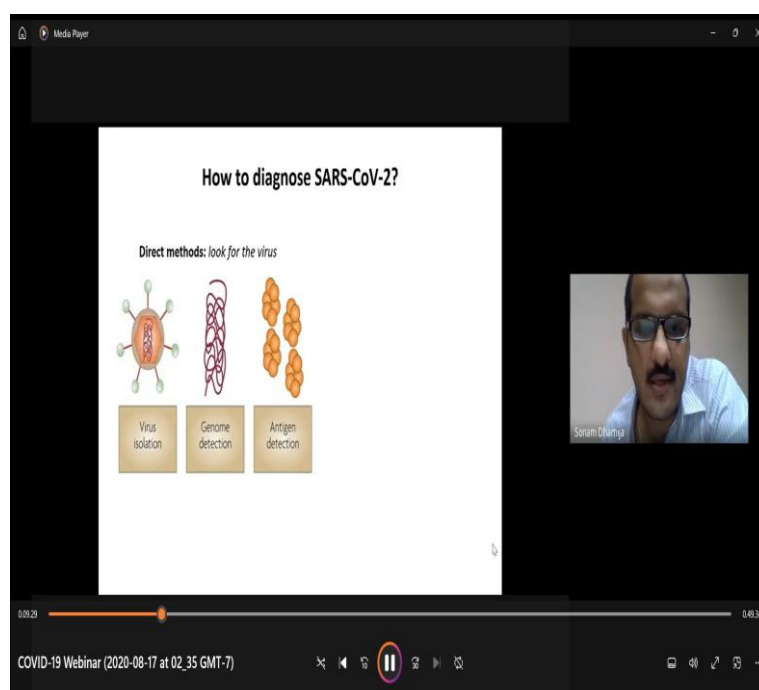

TOPIC: UNDERSTANDING COVID -19 DIAGNOSTICS-BEING POSITIVE ABOUT STAYING NEGATIVE

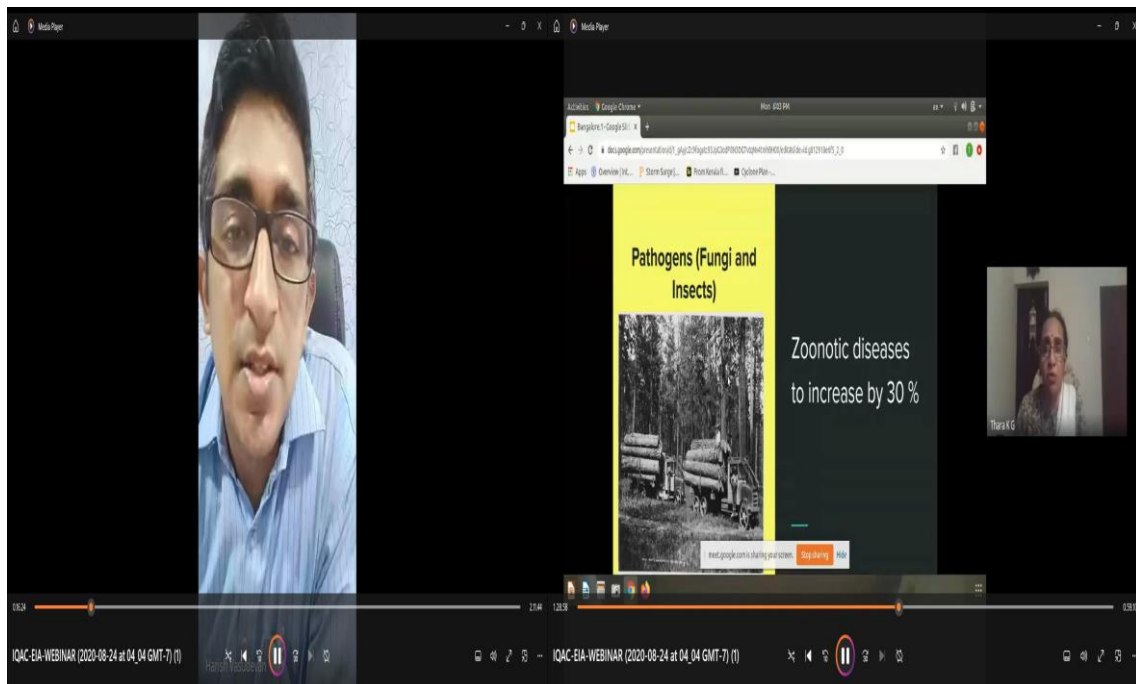

The main focus of the talk was on various testing methods used to detect the presence of Covid-19 viruses like RT-PCR, rapid antigen and antibody tests. He also compared the efficacy of different testing methods.

TOPIC: *CORONAYUM STHREE JEEVITHAVUM*



Vanitha Vedhi of Devaswom Board College organized a seminar on the topic 'Coronayum Sthree Jeevithavum' on 1st October 2020. Dr. R. Anitha, Principal, Devaswom Board College presided over the seminar. Chief guest was Prof. AG Oleena, Secretary, Purogamana kala sahithya sangam. The speaker had an interactive session with students and shared the view that the pandemic has disproportionately impacted women, from reduced economic opportunities and decreased access to reproductive and maternal health care, to increased incidence of sexual exploitation and gender-based violence. She also added that the World Economic Forum's 2021 Global Gender Gap Report found that "as the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic continues to be felt, closing the gender gap has increased by a generation from 99.5 years to 135.6 years.". She stressed about the prevalence of domestic violence in many households in the covid scenario. The seminar was attended by 80 participants.

TOPIC: MEDICAL PHYSICS: CONCEPTS AND APPLICATIONS

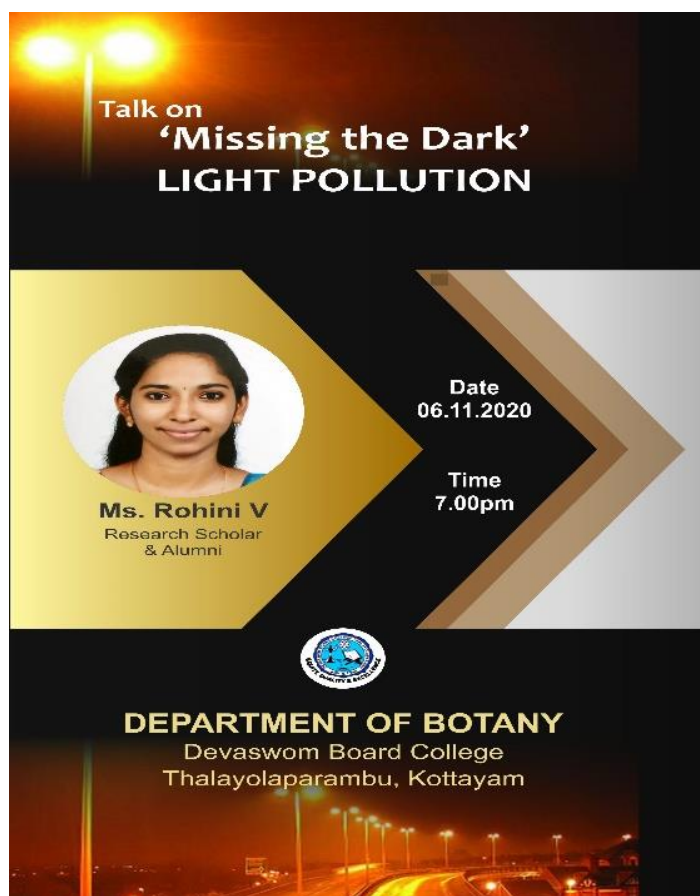

TOPIC: E- GOVERNANCE



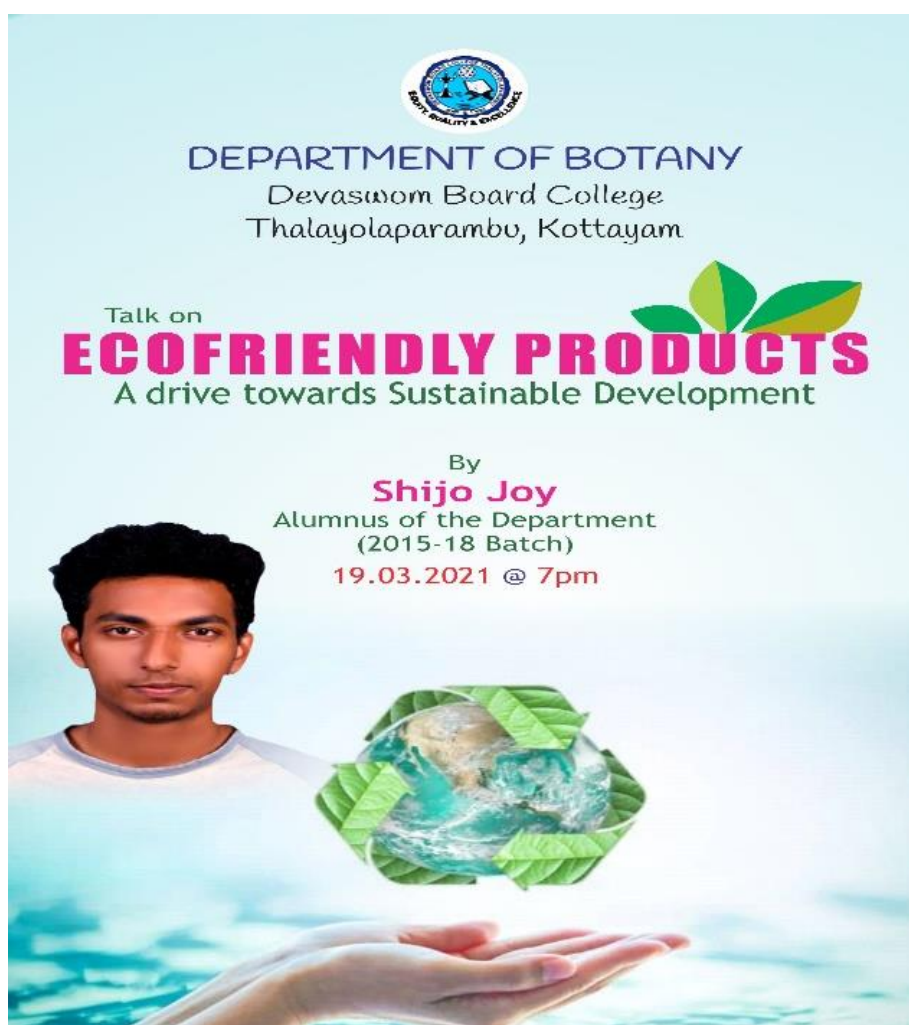



- Promote a variety of other important moral and social values, such as social responsibility, human rights, animal welfare, compliance with the law, and public health and safety. Ethical lapses in research can significantly harm human and animal subjects, students, and the public.

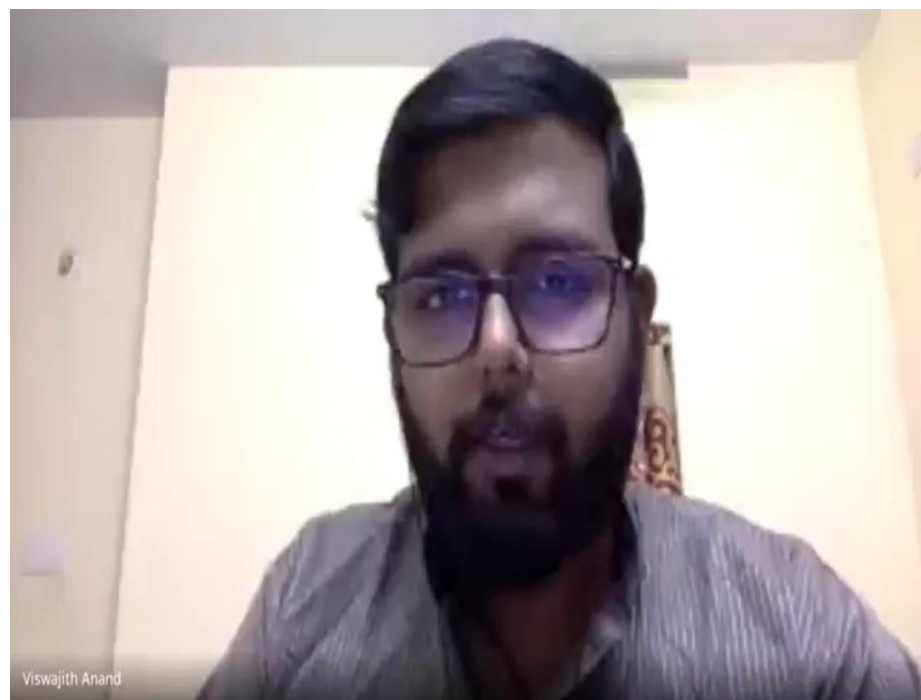

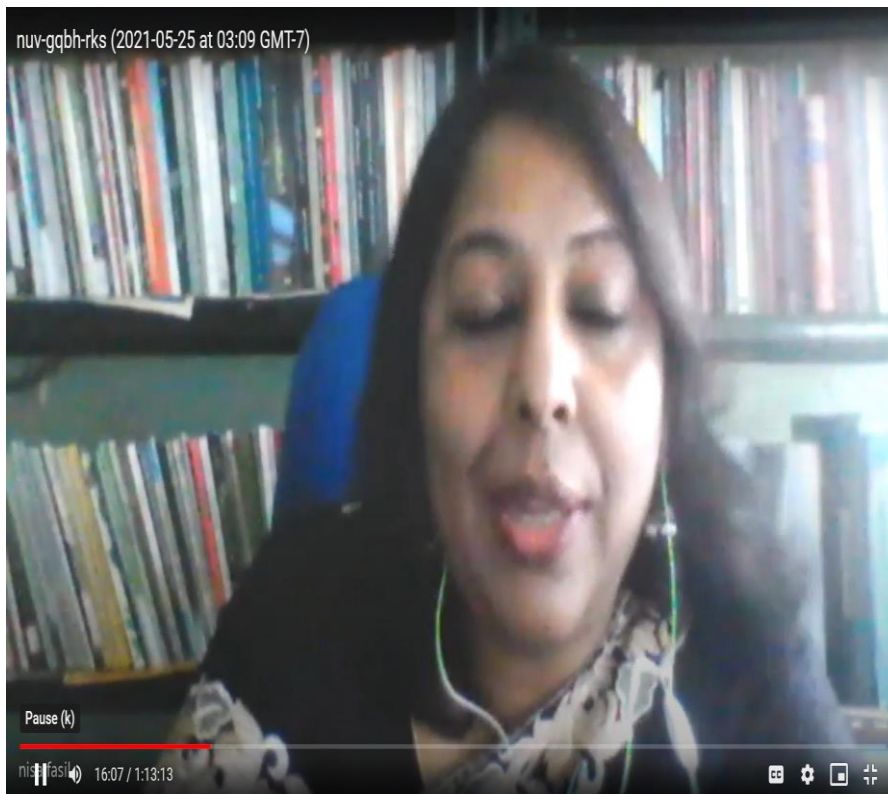

TOPIC: INDIAN LEGISLATURE PROTECTIONS FOR WOMEN


