


Survey and Environmental promotional activities



AWARENESS CAMPAIGN: BIODIVERSITY & ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

World Environment Day was celebrated by carrying out an Awareness Campaign named "Biodiversity and Environmental issues" on the 8th of June 2019. A field trip was jointly organized by Dept. of Botany and Biodiversity Club for both Botany students and members of Biodiversity Club which has given an opportunity for students to directly observe the habitat diversity and species diversity existing among the flora and fauna of the study areas. They also witnessed the degradation of certain ecosystems due to natural hazards as well as anthropogenic influences. 36 students participated in the programme.

SURVEY RAPID ASSESSMENT OF BIODIVERSITY LOSS AFTER FLOOD

Selected 1st and 2nd year students participated in a field survey entitled 'Rapid Assessment of Biodiversity loss after floods' in Vellur and Maravanthuruth Grama panchayats during 16-30th October 2018. This was a programme planned and carried out as per the instructions of Kerala State Biodiversity Board. A field training for conducting the survey was given to the experts at Alappuzha. Subsequently, two grama panchayats were assigned for conducting the survey. Field survey in these areas was carried out by the selected Botany students after training under the guidance of Dr. Nisha A, Assistant Professor Dept of Botany, D B College, Thalayolaparambu who was included in the panel of Subject experts for the assessment. Different wards in these Grama panchayats were visited with the active involvement of ward members and data pertaining to biodiversity loss subsequent to flood was investigated. The report of survey findings was given for compilation by the 'Biodiversity board' which submitted the consolidated report with recommendations to the Government.
