QUALITY INITIATIVES BY IQAC

PREPARATION OF ACADEMIC CALENDAR

In June 2022, the college academic calendar for the 2022-2023 year was prepared The calendar was crafted by incorporating a balanced mix of academic, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities, so as to foster a holistic learning environment for students. The preparation of Academic Calendar for 2022-2023 was supervised by IQAC. Departments, clubs, and cells submitted plans for their events to IQAC. Dr. Sumesh N, Assistant professor and member IQAC, compiled the calendar under the guidance of the principal and IQAC Coordinator. The academic calendar was released in the end of June 2022.

GREEN, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITS

IQAC initiated Green, Energy and environmental Audits to assess the institution's environmental impact, during the 2022-23 academic year. The auditing was done by "Advanced Centre of Environmental Studies and Sustainable Development", Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Dr. Deepa C S, Assistant professor and IQAC Co-ordinator, department of chemistry, coordinated the audit. The reports and analysis submitted by the agency were taken up for the implementation of green initiative in college measures by the institution.

ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUDIT

An internal Academic and Administrative Audit was conducted on 30/03/2023. The Audit was done under the chairman ship of Dr R Anitha, Principal, D B College with the support of IQAC members. They verified the criteria files which includes teachers diary, remedial and bridge course details, result analysis, scholarship details and other documents. 
SERVICE ADALATH FOR FACULTIES AND OFFICE STAFF





SEMINAR: MULTIFERROICS AND MEMORY STORAGE:- A FASCINATING CONTRIBUTION



MEDHA WEBINAR: APPLICATIONS OF PLANT TISSUE CULTURE



Advocate Mr. CT Thomas lead the class. The speaker mentioned about the section 66E of the IT Act which deals with the violation of the privacy of a person. Capturing, publishing or transmitting the image of a private area of any person without her consent, under circumstances violating her privacy, is punishable with imprisonment, which may extend to three years, and/or fine. He added that cybercrimes against women is at high and revenge pornography is what perpetrator of the crime usually uses against women. He educated the students about the Legal Provisions for women cyber security under various laws including, The Indian Penal Code, 1860. 55 participants attended the seminar.






PLANTING OF TREES


MAINTENANCE OF GARDEN




HELPDESK FOR LINKING AADHAR AND VOTER'S ID








RAMAYANA DAY

INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING




KARGIL VICTORY DAY


INTERNATIONAL DAY OF GIRL CHILD



INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY






ARTS CLUB INAUGURATION & ARTS FESTIVAL
